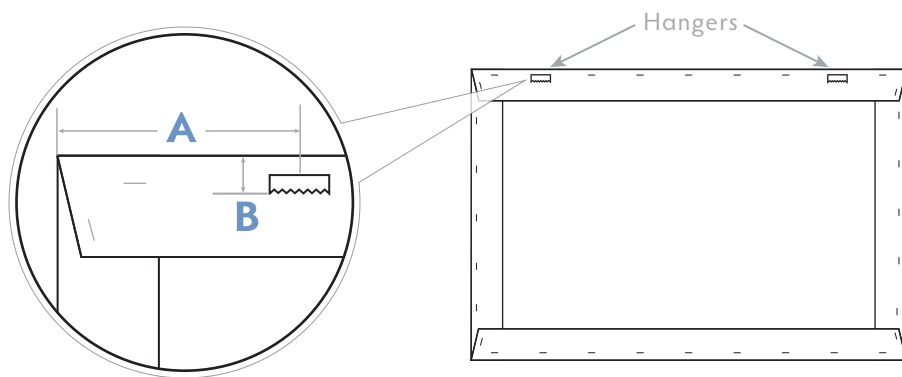


## WHAT YOU WILL NEED:



## YOUR MAP

On the back side of your map, at the top, there are 2 small metal hangers which will help to hang your map. You will need to take two measurements of the placement of these hangers, which will then be used throughout the hanging process.



**1:** Measure distances A & B (explained below) and record the results in the spaces provided below.

### THE MEASUREMENTS

**A** - The distance from the center of the hanger to the nearest side edge.

**DISTANCE A:** \_\_\_\_\_

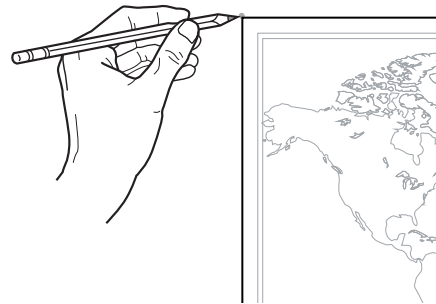
**B** - The distance from the top edge of the map to the bottom of the hanger.

**DISTANCE B:** \_\_\_\_\_

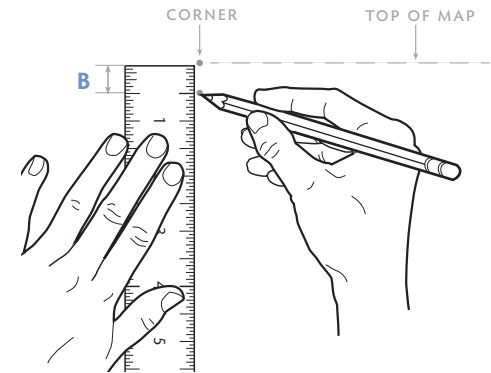
**2:** Hold the map up against the wall in your desired location, and make sure that it is level.



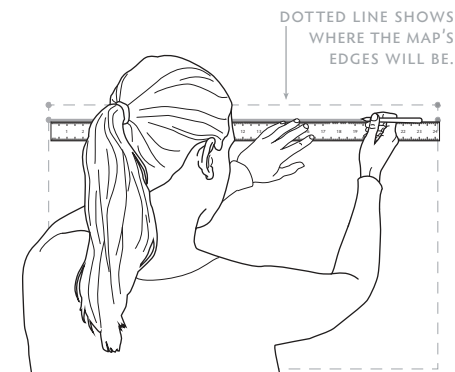
**3:** With the map held firmly in place (and level) lightly make a small pencil mark in the exact location of each top corner.



**4:** Measure (Distance B) straight down from each corner and make another 2 marks.

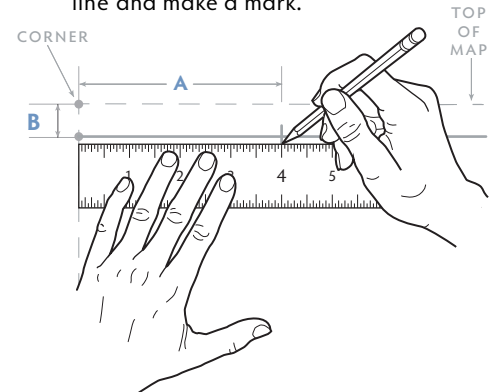


**5:** Then very lightly draw a straight line\* that connects both marks made in step 4.

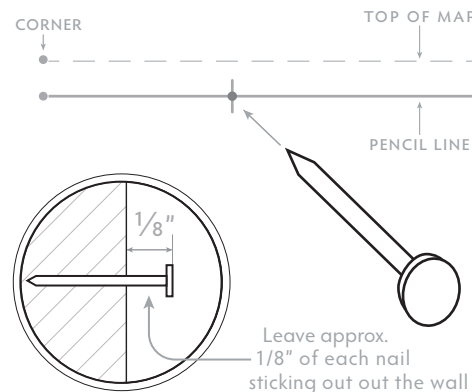


\* Verify this line is level before moving on to step 6

**6:** Measure (Distance A) inward (towards the center) from each end of the pencil line and make a mark.



**7:** Hammer the nails into the points where the marks from step 6 intersect with the line.



**8:** Erase/wipe off the pencil lines, and then hang your map on those nails and enjoy!
